INTRODUCTION

The town of Durham still celebrates an annual miners' gala festival, established in 1883. One of the last coalfields to close was Tower Colliery, in South Wales. Between these two regions, stands the history of coal generation and its importance to Britain's commercial and home life extending back to the industrial age.



In 1985, the last major industrial action by miners failed to stem the decline of their industry, with 50 mines soon earmarked for closure. Even Tower maintained an employee buy-out only for its final quarter-century. According to TUC officer, Dave Fieckert (*The Guardian*, 11.02.2004), the cost of closing the UK's mines has been almost half of the tax revenues collected from North Sea oil.

The increasing need for British self-sufficiency in energy supply may see coal returning as a prominent industry. This bibliography, comprised of monographs, periodicals and university theses, should serve as a starting point to understand the industry's history and current climate.

Topics include: Coal industry management and finance, trade union activity, women & children in mining communities, health & safety, the Bevin Boys of World War Two, and colliery closures. Medical publications and maps are not included.

DS shelfmark – the book is a **D**ocument **S**upply item. This means it can either be ordered for delivery to the Reading Rooms in London, which takes up to 48 hours, or ordered via inter-library loan through a University library or corporate account. 4. UNIVERSITY THESES

Access to most UK theses is now via EThOS (Electronic Theses Online Service) [http://ethos.bl.uk/], whether or not there is a record for the thesis on the British Library Integrated Catalogue. You can search EThOS without registering online, but you will need to register and login to the system if you wish to order or view a UK thesis.

If a thesis you wish to consult has already been digitised, you will be able to download it immediately on your own PC or laptop (you do not have to be in one of the British Library's reading rooms). It is also possible to view digitised theses on reading room PCs.

If a thesis has not yet been digitised and was awarded by a university participating in EThOS, it will be digitised from the original paper copy in response to your request and you will be notified by e-mail when the thesis is available for download (normally within 14 working days of the request). In most cases, the digitisation will be undertaken at no cost to you. However, theses awarded by a small number of UK universities will only be digitised on payment of a fee by the person requesting the thesis via EThOS for the first time.

It is also possible to order printed or CD/DVD versions of theses via EThOS, but a charge will apply. If a thesis was awarded by a university not participating in EThOS, you will have to contact the awarding university. If you have a reference for a thesis which you cannot find on EThOS, you can submit a "speculative request" via the website [http://ethos.bl.uk/SpeculativeRequest.do].

The strongly socialist Independent Labour Party (ILP) was established in Manchester in 1893. It pre-dated the Russian Communist revolution but at its peak between the World Wars, was politically positioned between the Labour Party and the Communist Party of Great Britain. Prominent members of the ILP included authors Ethel Mannin and George Orwell, MPs Ramsay Macdonald and Fenner Brockway, and women's rights activist Emmeline Pankhurst. The ILP was avowedly pacifist and so its alliances with other parties proved uneasy.
